BUTTERSCOTCH THE BEE!

Using 3.25mm (UK10) needles. Double knitting yarn Black, yellow and white. Stuffing approved for toys.

Abbreviations

CO: cast off

C + T: cut and thread. Cut working yarn leaving a long tail. Thread it onto a tapestry needle and thread it through the stitches on your knitting needle. Pull tight and fasten, use rest of yarn for sewing up.

DK: double knitting yarn

K: knit

K2tog: knit two stitches together

KfB: knit into front and back of the same stitch

P: purl

SS: stocking stitch. Knit one row purl one row

St/sts: stitch/stitches

S1 K1 PSSO: slip one stitch, knit one stitch, pass slip stitch over knitted stitch.

BODY

Working in stocking stitch of 8 rows per stripe.

- 1. Starting with Black cast on 16sts and ss 2 rows.
- 2. KfB in all sets (32sts)
- 3. Pall
- 4. (K1 KfB) to end (48sts)
- 5. SS 3 rows
- 6. Change to yellow ss 8 rows

- 7. Change to Black ss 6 rows
- 8. (K1 KfB) to end (72sts)
- 9. Pall
- 10. Continue in stripes until there are 9 stripes ending with black.
- 11. Continue without stripes in yellow and ss 4 rows
- 12. (K1 KfB K1) to end (96sts)
- 13. SS 5 rows
- 14. Form mouth K33 cast off 30 K33
- 15. P33, turn and cast on 30 knitwise, turn P33
- 16. SS 8 rows
- 17. K2tog, K20, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K20, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K20, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K20, K2tog
- 18. Pall
- 19. K2tog, K18, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K18, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K18, K2tog, S1 K1 PSSO, K18, k2tog
- 20. P all
- 21. Keep reducing (keeping decrease seams in line) until there are 16 sets
- 22. Leave a length of yarn to join head seam, C + T.

EYE BACKS. - make 2

- 1. In white DK cast on 24sts
- 2. Starting with purl row ss 3 rows
- 3. (K2tog) to end
- 4. C + T Pull tight, use tail to sew eye backs forming a circle.

EYE MIDDLE - make 2

- 1. In black cast on 8sts
- 2. C + T. pull tight and sew to form circle.

MOUTH POCKET

- 1. Using Black cast on 30 sts
- 2. Work in either ss or garter stitch for 20-24cm. Cast off.

I-Cord Lips

- 1. Make a separate I-cord and sew around mouth edge after the pocket is joined to body opening.
- 2. Using double pointed needles cast on 3 sts Knit 1 row. Slide stitches to the other end of the needle and knit again. Repeat until desired length is reached C + T.

ANTENNA - make 2

- 1. Using Black cast on 12sts
- 2. SS 12 rows
- 3. (K1 KfB) to end of row (18sts)
- 4. P next and all wrong side rows
- 5. (K1 KfB) to end of row (27sts)
- 6. SS 5 rows
- 7. K1 K2tog) to end of row
- 8. (K2tog) to end of row
- 9. Repeat last decreasing row until 5 sts remain. C+T.
- 10. Sew edges together and stuff.

11. **LEGS** - make 6

- 1. In DOUBLE DK Black/yellow cast on 25sts
- 2. SS 8 rows
- 3. CO leaving long tail
- 4. Roll lengthwise and sew down edge.

WINGS - make 2

- 1. Using white DK cast on 80 sts
- 2. SS 8 rows
- 3. (K6, K2 tog) to end of row (70sts)
- 4. SS 3 rows
- 5. (K5 K2tog) to end of row (60sts)
- 6. SS 3 rows
- 7. (K4 K2tog) to end of row (50sts)
- 8. SS 3 rows
- 9. (K3 K2tog) to end of row (40sts)
- 10. SS 3 rows
- 11. (K2 K2tog) to end of row (30sts)
- 12. SS 3 rows
- 13. (K1 K2tog) to end of row (20sts)
- 14. SS 3 rows
- 15. (K2tog) to end (10sts)
- 16. Purl
- 17. Cast off.
- 18. Sew up side seams and cast off edges.

TO MAKE UP

- 1. Sew back seam to half way then stuff.
- 2. Sew pocket to top and bottom lip
- 3. Sew up pocket sides and secure pocket in several places on inside of body.
- 4. Sew up rest of body and stuff.
- 5. Sew on eye backs/middles
- 6. Attach antenna.
- 7. Position wings either side of back seam. Attach securely.
- 8. Add legs to sides of body in sets of 2 evenly spaced.

NB. Please ensure that the stuffing you use is approved for toys, and had a BS or CE label on the packaging. No other stuffings may be used, thank you.

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
